CFA had record breaking support in 2021 and surpassed all Spring Plant & Gift Sale and Toast for Tails fundraising and sponsorship records of years past.

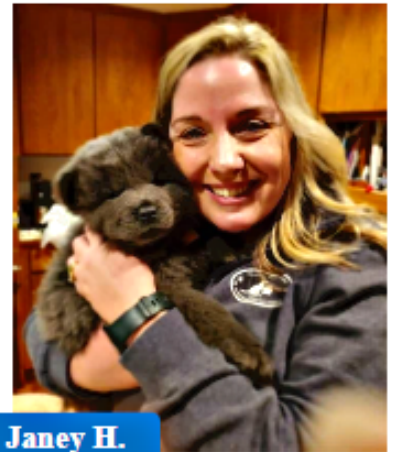
